About Woodland

Position Overview

We are seeking a compassionate and engaging **Family Minister** to lead our children's and youth ministries. This full-time position plays a vital role in the life of Woodland by helping our youngest members grow in faith, feel fully seen and valued, and find their place in our community. The Family Minister will work alongside a dedicated team of staff and volunteers to create meaningful, age-appropriate, and inclusive programming from nursery through high school.

Key Responsibilities

- Develop and oversee all aspects of children's and youth ministries, including Sunday School, midweek programming, and special events.
- Cultivate an engaging, spiritually enriching environment for children, youth, and families that reflects Woodland's progressive theology and values.
- Recruit, train, and support volunteers and leaders for teaching, mentoring, and event support.
- Partner with parents and caregivers to nurture faith at home and within the life of the church.
- Create opportunities for intergenerational connection and integration in worship and service.

- Collaborate with staff in aligning family ministry with the broader mission of Woodland.
- Ensure compliance with child safety and protection policies and best practices.

Qualifications

- A calling to Christian ministry with children, youth, and families in a church context.
- Bachelor's degree required; theological education or equivalent experience strongly preferred.
- Experience in children's and/or youth ministry, ideally in a church or nonprofit setting.
- Strong relational and communication skills, with a heart for pastoral care.
- Creativity, initiative, and a collaborative spirit.
